As we mentioned above, some brands have already started to update their packaging in advance. Until the new app launches, if you see the new Box Tops label on packages, you can use the current Box Tops Bonus App to earn Box Tops for that product. Simply download the app, select the bonus offer for the product you've purchased and scan your receipt to earn.

Note From Nurse Katy

Flu season is upon us at Spirit Lake Elementary School. Please help in reducing the spread of illness by keeping your child at home when they are sick, and waiting to return to school and other activities in the community until they are well enough to participate fully.

School policy is that students must stay home and/or will be sent home from school if they have a temperature of 100.0 or higher, if they have vomited, or they have more than 1 episode of diarrhea. They need to stay home 24 hours after the last temperature of 100.0 or higher without fever reducing medication (Tylenol or Ibuprofen), and 24 hours after the last episode of vomiting or diarrhea. They need to be well enough to participate in school.

We have had some students that did not feel well for a day or two before they started running a fever.

The best defense against influenza is preventing it. Please encourage frequent hand washing, proper nutrition and a full night's sleep. Included in this email is an update from the CDC.

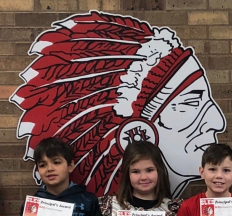
