

For one, we had to order additional sweat pants and shirts (Thank you Rachel!) and it became difficult at times to find an event for every 7th grader in the meets with very limited participation (like the Lakes Conference Meet). However, the positives outweigh the negatives by far. During the majority of meets, Coach Schmidt was able to get everyone involved and he did a great job of working with the kids to get them into events that they enjoyed doing.

In terms of outcomes, our team was not only large but also very successful on the track. Our 8th Grade Boys Track team finished the year undefeated and finished the season as the Lakes Conference Champions for the third year in a row. Our 7th Grade Boys Track team also finished the year undefeated (against other 7th grade teams) and won the Lakes Conference Championship by a wide margin (45 points!). So overall, it was a very successful year in terms of both participation and performance.

#### Notes from the year:

This group of girls has also played together with parent coaching for 3 or 4 years. It is a valuable experience and gives the athletes a good foundation from which to build. If at all possible, having our varsity coach meet with and encourage certain specifics be taught and coached, it would allow for a continuation of skills and program building. This group was solid and grew in skills and confidence. This group also beat teams this year they had not yet beaten at all last year.

#### Suggestions for next year:

The schedule was ok, busy at times with less practice time than needed at times. If possible can the Athletic Directors discuss the "no press" rule for the B teams? If possible we would like the girls to be able to play as normal, allowing for turn overs and rebounding after a shot to give them a real feel for the game. After a 15 or so point lead the pressure is not allowed. This could also be decided by the coaches on a game by game basis.


