## Principal Report

- Fundraiser was a success
- Fall Blast - $\$ 75$ will be allocated to each classroom
- Mrs. Vancura will send a document to families describing what each grade will be doing for Fall Blast
- Safety Week is this week. Students will be going to the fire station and practicing bus evacuation drills
- Parents will be invited to attend the Halloween parade. Mrs. Vancura will send out information to parents regarding the details. The parade will take place in the elementary gym.
- Principal for a Day is selected each month. The students are randomly selected from a generator. The selected student helps with morning announcements, has lunch in Mrs. Vancura's office, wears a suit coat, and helps with the crosswalk after school.
- The outdoor classroom is being utilized more this year. Some supplies that were ordered are missing, such as magnifying glasses, clipboards, containers, etc. Mrs. Vancura will find out if there are additional items teachers would like to have in the outdoor classroom, and PIE will order more materials.
- Update for playground - Mrs. Vancura will meet with Dr. Smith again this week to determine what grants can be applied for and how to keep the project moving.

- Kids were not as excited about the keychains this year. We can consider providing something different next year. Second and third grade teachers and classes were the most enthusiastic and involved.
- Delivery of fundraiser materials will be November 9, after lunch. Volunteers are needed to organize and distribute materials.
- Rachel or Jamie will send out a Signup Genius to make sure we have enough volunteers for afternoon and evening shifts.

## Book Fair

- Mrs. Vancura currently gives out 2 coins per teacher each month for the book vending machine.
