Registration Process

- *(For current families with students already in the district.)* You will need to use your Infinite Campus (IC) Parent Portal account to register for school. IC is our student information system. If you do not have a parent portal account you will register as a new student and set up a parent portal account through infinite campus.
- Registration for the 2024-2025 school year will begin this summer. You will register within your parent portal account if you already have students in the district. If you already have children in the district, you can add the new student when registering your other children within IC Parent Portal.
- *(For families that are new to the district with no other children in the district)* - When Online Registration becomes available this summer, you will register as a new student. Simply click the new student registration link on the [school website](#). Once registered, the office will reach out with any information they need. Contact the elementary office with any questions.
 - *If you attended Pre-K at Spirit Lake, you will register as an existing student in your Parent Portal account.*

Nurse Info. and Health Forms

The following is due the first day of school. These appointments can be completed between February and August.

- [IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS](#) - We need a valid Immunization certificate or Immunization exemption waiver (students can not start school until this is on file with the school)
- [PHYSICAL FORMS](#) - Completed by a doctor with blood lead test
- [SICK DAY GUIDELINES](#) - review
- [VISION CARD](#) - Completed by an Eye Doctor
- [DENTAL SCREEN](#) - Completed by a Dentist

These are required for kindergarten. PreK and TK need a valid immunization certificate, a completed physical, and review of sick day guidelines.



TK (Transitional Kindergarten)

What is TK?

Answer: Transitional Kindergarten is a school year that serves as a bridge between preschool and kindergarten, functioning to provide students with time to develop fundamental skills needed for success in school in a developmentally-appropriate setting.
