## FAQ

- Q. Isn't there a new playground nearby?
  - P. Yes, there is a community playground thanks to a generous donor. It's fantastic and heavily used but not suitable for elementary students during the school day.
- Q. Why is a new playground needed?
  - A. The existing playground has been in use for almost three decades. It is challenging to locate parts and repair when problems arise. The surface and play area are also not accessible for all students.
- Q. What about the newer structures?
  - Ch. The recently installed components of the playground will remain. The plan includes retaining the newer elements and designing the new playground layout to incorporate them.
- Q. Will it be handicap accessible?
  - The new park will be designed to be fully accessible to students of all ages and abilities. This improvement will allow all students to engage with the play structures and navigate the area with ease.
