Some years that can be a negative, but with this group it was done very well and a great benefit. Thank you parents for taking the time and interest in encouraging the girls.

Notes from the year:

As noted this group has played together in travel ball, and their experience showed. They were able to continue building on concepts and skills to improve their play.

Suggestions for next year:

The biggest issue this year was the amount of practice time compared to games played. We had scheduled 11 games and only 11 practices. Then two of those practices were lost due to weather issues. Ideally, if there is a way to spread out the games more, giving us a couple weeks to start the season, then a practice or two between games during the season it would be very beneficial.

Additionally, in discussing practice time with other schools, they are currently practicing on Wednesdays. We do not, so is that a district policy? Is it possible to look into that option, especially for this year, it would have been a great help in teaching and prepping for games.

- 5)Continued building of positive relationships through team building activities.**

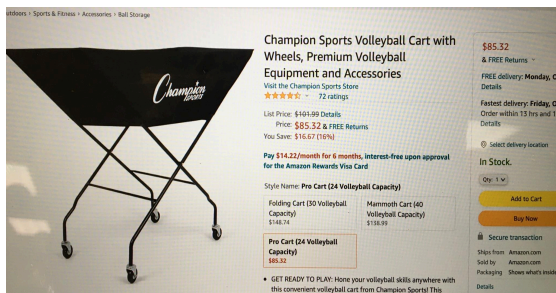

Extra Comments:

-We have greatly enjoyed coaching this season's 7th grade volleyball players. We had a very diverse group of 28 players with a wide range of skills. Our team focus was unity. We wanted to build a family centered culture where our expectations were high, our girls would learn to think of others, give back to our school, and positively impact the lives of others. We challenged our players to learn new skills, positions, plays, and techniques. As coaches you always need to be willing to learn, reflect, and adapt. I feel we have middle school volleyball coaches with passion, grit, grace, a willingness to study and deeper learn the game, and are developing an understanding that we are coaching more than volleyball. We as coaches are asked to mentor, work on mental toughness, help players overcome emotions that are building from outside of practice/games and affect them inside of practice/games, and be even more flexible. I feel it would be beneficial to sit down as middle school coaches with our AD to lay out a plan of action/protocol for handling injuries, parental issues, and other concerns prior to next session. We look forward to coaching next year's 7th graders, and hope to continue to help build a strong volleyball program within the middle school full of athletes who enjoy the game of volleyball and want to continue to grow in their skills and understanding.
