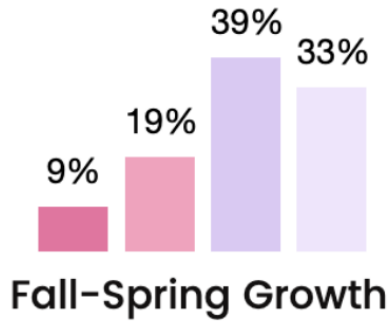

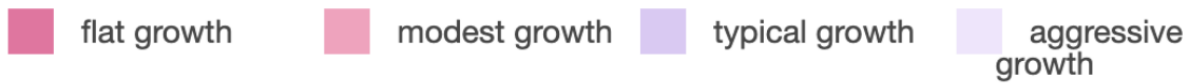

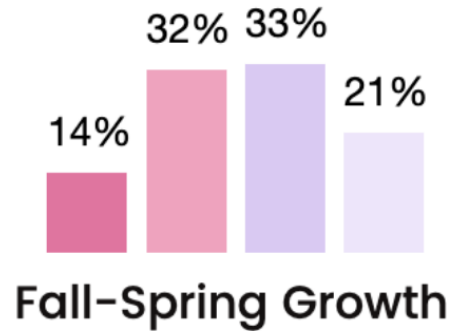
2022-2024 School Year

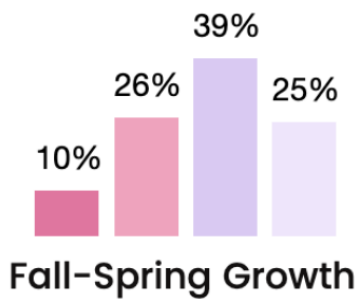

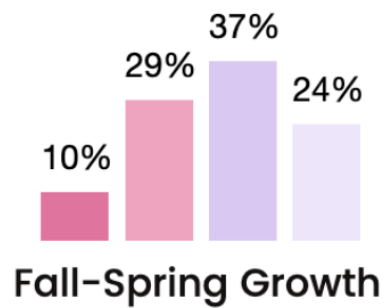

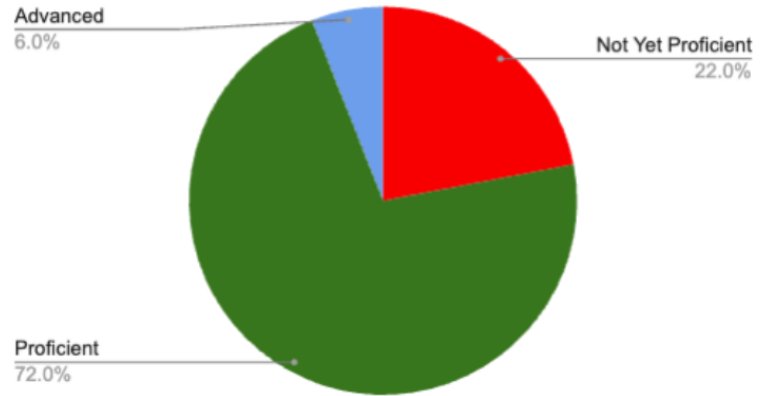

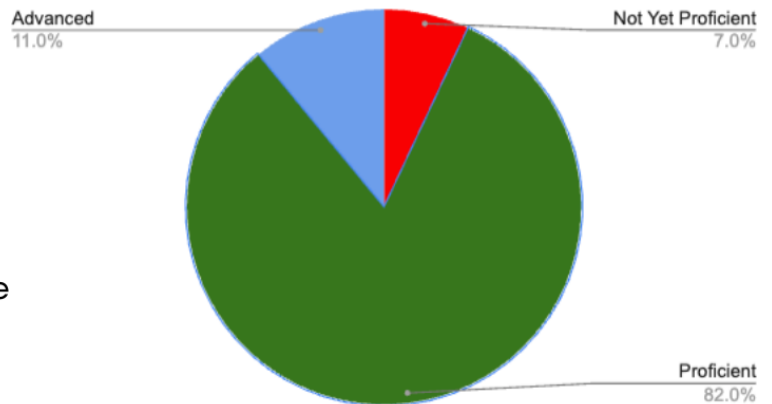

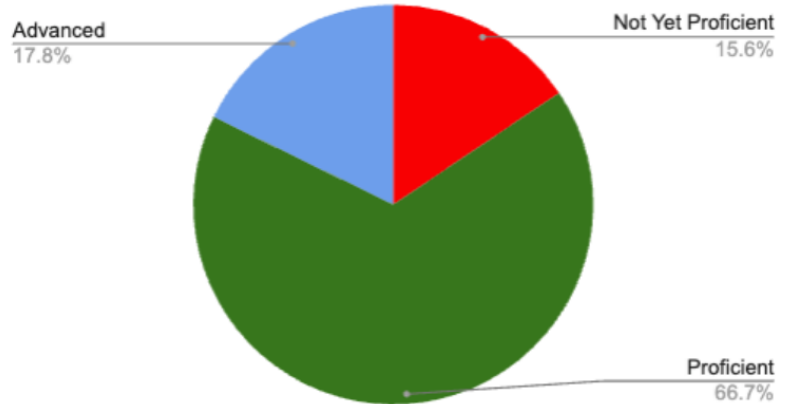

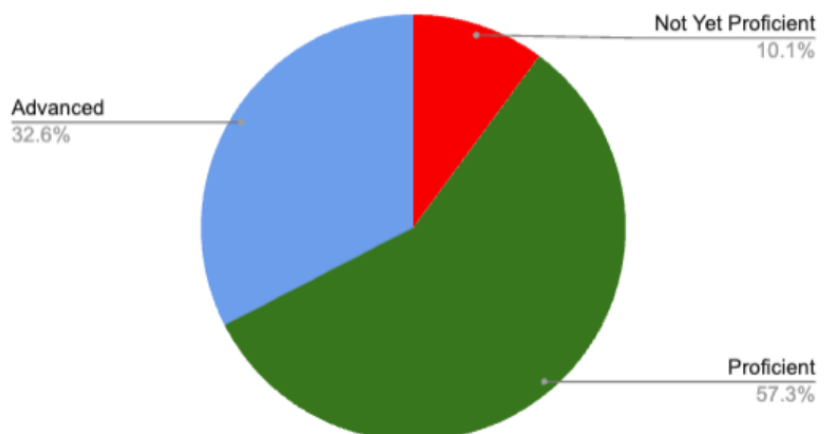
3rd Grade ELA 2023-2024
